CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS & GUESTS

The Brainerd Family YMCA is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members, community members and guests. To promote safety & comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are in YMCA facilities or participating in YMCA programs.

We expect all persons using the YMCA to behave in a mature & responsible way and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct for Members, community members & guests does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person. Specifically, this includes:

- Angry or vulgar language including swearing, name calling or shouting.
- Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening way.
- Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person.
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures and body language.
- Theft or behavior which results in the destruction of property.
- Carrying or concealing any weapons, devices or objects, which may be used as weapons.
- Using, possessing or being under the influence of illegal chemicals or alcohol on YMCA property, in YMCA vehicles, or at YMCA sponsored programs.
- Any other conduct of an inappropriate, threatening or offensive nature.
- Unauthorized cameras, cell phones, PDAs & video recording devices are prohibited in all locker room areas unless used by medical, law enforcement, YMCA, or EMT personnel in emergency situations.

Members, community members and guests are encouraged to be responsible for their personal comfort and safety and ask any person whose behavior threatens their comfort to refrain. If a member or guest feels uncomfortable in confronting the person directly, they should report the behavior to a staff person immediately.

The CEO or Leadership Staff will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of YMCA membership program privileges may result from a determination by the CEO or Leadership Staff if in his or her discretion a violation of this Code of Conduct has occurred. YMCA Staff on duty may revoke facility usage privileges until such determination is made.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

The undersigned Community Member, individually and on behalf of all minor children and heirs (together, "Community Member") agrees that any use of the Brainerd Family YMCA ("YMCA") services or facilities shall be undertaken by Community Member at Community Member's sole risk and that the YMCA shall not be liable for any claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions or causes of action to Community Member or his or her property arising out of or connected with the use of any of the services and facilities of the YMCA or the premises where the services are located. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Community Member hereby forever releases and discharges the YMCA from all such claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions or causes of action, and from all acts of negligence on the part of the YMCA and its employees, directors, officers or agents.

Community Member further agrees that the YMCA is not responsible for personal property lost or stolen while Community Member is using the facilities or is on its premises.

Community Member has read and agrees to abide by the YMCA's Code of Conduct and all policies and guidelines, currently in place or hereafter enacted.
